Student Parking & Transportation Information Fall Semester 2011

■ **St. Joseph's Garage** – Located behind the Sibley Building on North Clinton Avenue and Pleasant Street

Hourly Rate: 50¢ every 20 minutes Monday-Friday; daily maximum \$6
\$2 after 4:30 pm Monday-Friday and Saturday 7 am-1 pm (when garage closes); closed Sunday

Fall Semester: **\$95 parking fee + \$10 refundable keycard deposit** for registered MCC students enrolled in one class or more at Damon City Campus. Limited number of semester parking keycards available on first-come first-served basis.

- ▶ Take completed application with \$105 to DCC Registration & Financial Services.
- ▶ Receive keycard to enter/exit garage throughout semester.
- ▶ Keycard is activated from August 16, 2011, through December 22, 2011.

Garage Hours: All keycard holders have access to the garage 24/7. Ticket holders, however, need to retrieve their vehicle before garage closing time, or else wait until the garage opens again. Garage hours of operation are Monday-Friday 6 am-10 pm, Saturday 7 am-1pm, Sunday closed.

■ **Mortimer Street Garage** – Located at 83 Mortimer St. at Clinton Ave., across the street from the Sibley Building

Monthly Rate: \$35 / Hourly Rate: 0-2 hours \$1; each additional hour (or any part of) add \$1 per hour up to daily maximum \$5. Daily rates are paid at pay station upon entering the garage; pay with credit/debit card or coins only (no paper cash). Garage opens at 6:30 am on Monday and closes at 10 pm on Friday. Skybridge links the garage and second floor of the Sibley Building (Clinton Ave. doors to Sibley Building remain locked).

■ **East End Garage** – Located at 475 E. Main St. at Scio St., next to the Eastman Theatre

Student Discount Rate: 25¢ per half-hour and daily maximum \$4.75 with current MCC student ID card. Discount rate available only when exiting staffed cashier lanes. Free after 5:30 pm. Free on weekends (excluding special events).

■ **South Avenue Garage** – Located at 39 Stone St. at South Ave.

Hourly Rate: 0-2 hours \$1; each additional hour (or any part of) add \$1 per hour up to daily maximum \$6.75
Monthly Rate: \$79

■ **Others** – There are several outside lots in the vicinity surrounding Damon City Campus; monthly and daily rates vary. Parking meters are located in the area as well.

■ **Handicapped Parking** – Available on the streets and in the garages. For information about handicap permits call the City Clerk's Office at City Hall at 585/428-6617.

■ **Shuttle Service Between Damon City Campus & Brighton Campus**

During the fall and spring semesters, MCC provides free direct shuttle service between Damon City Campus and Brighton Campus to current MCC students and employees with valid MCC ID. The shuttle is wheelchair-accessible. The shuttle leaves both campuses every half-hour from 7:30 am until 2:30 pm, and every hour thereafter until 9 pm during the week-days during fall and spring. Passengers are required to swipe their MCC ID cards upon entering the shuttle. Pick-up/drop-off points are the Franklin Street entrance to the Sibley Building downtown and Gilman Lounge – Bldg. 3 at the Brighton Campus. Schedules are available in the Campus Center Office at Damon City Campus, in the Office of Student Life and Leadership Development at the Brighton Campus, at shuttle stops, and online (www.monroecc.edu, A-Z Index, S – Shuttle).

■ **Bus Travel Between Damon City Campus & Brighton Campus**

Bus #50 leaves the Sibley Building (on Clinton Ave. northbound) and stops at the Brighton Campus.
Bus #24 leaves Main and St. Paul (on St. Paul southbound) and stops across the street from the Brighton Campus.
Bus schedules are available in the DCC 5th floor lounge; bus passes may be purchased at the Bookstore's Service Desk.

■ **Parking at the MCC Brighton Campus**

Students who park at the MCC Brighton Campus must obtain and display a parking permit or park at a meter. Contact the Parking Office at the Brighton Campus at 585/292-2700 for more information.
